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1. Mr. J. Sai Deepak, learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the Decree Holder, fairly submits that the issue with respect to the computation of the decretal amount is presently pending consideration before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.



2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Judgment Debtor submits that, in view of the aforesaid position, the present matter may be taken up after the next date of hearing before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, which is stated to be 18.05.2026.
