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1. The petitioner has approached this Court assailing the orders dated 19.02.2010 and 11.05.2010 passed by the learned Employees' Provident Fund Appellate Tribunal.
2. During the pendency of the present petition, the matter has, pursuant to the directions issued by this Court on 23.10.2019 been reconsidered by the Central Board of Trustees (CBT) of the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation in its meeting held on 10.03.2021. A decision has now been taken by the CBT to reduce the demand towards penal damages raised on the petitioner from Rs.13,45,630/- to Rs.6,72,815/. A copy of the communication dated 10.03.2021 conveying the said decision to the petitioner has been handed over in Court and is taken on record.
3. In the light of the aforesaid once the impugned orders itself stand



modified, nothing further survives for adjudication in the present petition, which is, accordingly, disposed of.

4. It is, however, made clear that any deposits, which may have been made by the petitioner before this Court would alongwith accrued interest thereon, be released in favour of the respondent and would be adjusted towards the amount payable by the petitioner in terms of the aforesaid communication dated 10.03.2021.
