ORDER

Matter taken up today as 14.8.2017 was declared a holiday on account of Janamashtami.

The payer made in the present petition is that the order passed by the respondent no.1 dated 01.01.2016 be set aside. Record shows that the petitioner had sought permission from the Central Government for a renewal of his institution for the Academic Session 2015-16. His case was rejected. He was constrained to file WP(C) No.9663/2015 vide which learned Single Judge had remanded the



matter back to the Central Government to consider the case of the petitioner afresh; this was vide order dated 29.12.2015. The case of the petitioner was considered afresh. It was thereafter rejected on 01.01.2016. This is the grievance in the present petition.

Learned senior counsel appearing for respondent points out that the case of the petitioner has been rejected for the year 2015-16 and the other prayers which are made along with the prayer No.(a) would no longer survive as his prayer seeking admission for the academic year 2015-16 is not possible. His additional submission is that the order passed by the Single Judge dated 29.12.2015 in WP(C) 9663/2015 was the subject matter of appeal before the LPA Bench and the LPA Bench vide order dated 06.02.2017 had admitted the LPA and listed it in Regular Matters.

Learned counsel appearing for the parties agree that this matter be adjourned sine die with liberty granted to the petitioner to have it mentioned once the LPA is decided.

Petition adjourned sine die.
