1. Petitioner seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against respondent MCD for not taking any action in terms of the specific directions contained in order dated 22.11.2024 passed by learned Coordinate Bench of this Court in W.P.(C) 16247/2024.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, to the best of her information and knowledge, the neighbour i.e. Mr. Vikram Singh, who was respondent No.2 in the above said writ petition has not so far, filed any appeal before learned Appellate Tribunal, MCD and, therefore, there was no reason for MCD to not have taken any further action in accordance with law and pursuant to the above said order.
3. Learned counsel for respondent MCD appears on advance notice



and seeks time to file status report.

4. In order to have complete clarity with respect to the controversy in the present contempt petition, petitioner seeks permission to implead Mr. Vikram Singh also as one of the respondents in the present petition.

5. Such request is acceded to.

6. Let amended Memo of Parties be filed within one week and thereafter process be issued to said newly impleaded Mr. Vikram Singh through all permissible modes, returnable on 28th March, 2025.
