3. The present petition has been filed alleging deliberate and willful disobedience of the order dated 03rd October, 2023 passed by learned Metropolitan Magistrate ("MM"), Mahila Court-01, District South-East, Saket Court, New Delhi in *Domestic Violence Case No. 1059/2022*. Thus,



by way of the present petition, the petitioner has prayed that the due arrears of maintenance amounting to total of Rs. 16,80,933/- towards maintenance, be paid to the petitioner.

4. Per contra, learned counsel appearing for respondent on advance notice has handed over certain documents to show that the respondent has been making payment of Rs. 90,000/- per month to the petitioner. Learned counsel for respondent further submits that the respondent is also ready to reimburse any extra payment towards the medical bills, if the medical bills are provided to the respondent.

5. She further submits that the petitioner may not send any communication on the official e-mail of the respondent. Thus, she submits that any e-mail on behalf of the petitioner should be sent to the following e-mail address viz. vivek.singh@live.com.

6. After some arguments, both the parties are agreeable that the matter ought to be referred to mediation so that the parties can resolve their differences.

7. Considering the joint request made on behalf of parties, the present matter is referred to the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre, to be listed before a Senior Mediator on 29th January, 2024.
