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1. Learned counsel for the petitioner reiterates that there is wilful and deliberate disobedience of order dated 03.10.2023 passed by learned Mahila Court whereby the maintenance was awarded to the petitioner herein.
2. It is submitted that when the present petition was filed, the arrears with respect to the maintenance were more than Rs.16 lacs which is now stated to be around Rs.20 lacs, after adjusting the amount, which was, in the interregnum, received from the respondent.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent, whereas, submits that as per the instructions which she has received from respondent, the entire maintenance amount has already been duly paid.
4. When asked, learned counsel for the petitioner also apprised that



the petitioner has also filed an execution petition and since the respondent herein has not been appearing, learned Executing Court has already issued fresh warrants of arrest against him and the next date in such execution is stated to be 20.03.2025.

5. It is submitted that since there are huge arrears with respect to maintenance, it is a fit case where this contempt petition should be fast-tracked.

6. The respondent shall appear in person on the next date and would also file an affidavit along with the supporting documents, if any, clearly indicating as to what payment has been made by him after the order dated 03.10.2023 and in what manner.

7. Re-notify on 23rd December, 2024.

8. The matter be shown in supplementary list.
