1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

CM APPL. 7197/2023 -Delay 44 days (RF).

3. This is an application filed by the appellant seeking condonation of 44 days delay in re-filing the appeal.
4. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the delay of 44 days in re-filing the appeal is condoned.
5. The application stands disposed of.

MAC.APP. 83/2023 & CM APPL. 7195/2023 -Delay 272 days

6. The present appeal preferred by the claimant under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicle Acts seeks to assail the award dated 23.08.2021 passed by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal in MACT No. 2451/2016 insofar as the quantum of compensation is concerned.



7. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the compensation awarded by the learned Tribunal is highly inadequate.
8. Issue notice. Learned counsel for the respondent no.2, who is the only contesting respondent, accepts notice. He prays for and is granted four weeks time to file reply to the application. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within four weeks thereafter.
