3. Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner.
4. The proceedings of instant Contempt Petition have been instituted alleging disobedience of an order dated 07.08.2025 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA 221/2024.
5. It has been stated by the learned Counsel for the Petitioner that the Court *vide* aforesaid order dated 07.08.2025 had provided that the Petitioner would not be disqualified to participate in the selection process only on the basis of the age, and, therefore, the Court further observed that this was a fit case permitting the Petitioner to take part in the examination to be conducted by Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board (“DSSSB”). The examination is set to have been held on 10.08.2025 and 14.08.2025.
6. It has been stated by the learned Counsel for the Petitioner despite the said order dated 07.08.2025, the Petitioner was not permitted to appear in the examination which was held on 10.08.2025 and 14.08.2025.
7. There is nothing in the Petition wherefrom he can refer as to when and by what mode the authorities of DSSSB were apprised of the order dated 07.08.2025 passed by this Court and further as to when and by what mode, the Petitioner sought issuance of the admit card for the examination which was held on 10.08.2025 and 14.08.2025.



8. Let an additional affidavit be filed by the Petitioner to establish the aforesaid facts, within a period of two weeks.
