CM APPL. 7516/2019/Condonation of delay in refiling the Appeal]

1. This is an Application filed on behalf of the Appellant seeking condonation of delay of 18 days in refiling the Appeal.
2. For the reasons as stated in the Application, the delay is condoned.
3. The Application is, accordingly, disposed of.

[Delay in re-filing the Appeal]**

6. Learned Counsel for the Appellant and Respondent No.5 seek and are granted time to file their respective written synopsis, not exceeding three pages each, at least three days before the next date of hearing, along with the compilation of judgments, if any, they wish to rely upon.

6.1 All judgments sought to be relied upon shall be filed with an index which also sets out the relevant paragraph numbers and the proposition of law that it sets forth.
