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3. The present petition alleges wilful disobedience / non-compliance with the directions passed in the order dated 12.11.2025. The operative directions therein are as under:

“7. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of taking the assurance of the Respondent on record that representation dated 21.03.2025 will be decided within four weeks. The decision taken by MCD will be communicated to the Petitioners within a week from the date of the decision. It will be open to the Petitioners to take recourse to appropriate remedies to challenge the decision, in the event the Petitioners are aggrieved by the said decision, in accordance with law. It is made clear that Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and all rights and contentions of the respective parties are left open.”

4. Learned counsel for the respondents, who appears on advance notice, submits that the representation of the petitioner is under active consideration and shall be disposed of within a period of two weeks from today.
