I.A. 1467/2025 (Exemption from filing certified/original, legible/typed and properly margined copies of documents)

1. The present is an application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ("CPC"), on behalf of the plaintiff, seeking exemption from filing certified/original, legible/typed and properly margined copies of documents.
2. Exemption is granted, subject to all just exceptions.
3. Plaintiff shall file certified/original, legible/typed and properly



margined copies of documents, on which the plaintiff may seek to place reliance, before the next date of hearing.

4. Accordingly, the present application is disposed of.

I.A. 1468/2025 (Application seeking exemption from Pre-Institution Mediation)

5. Learned counsel appearing for the plaintiff submits that the plaintiff has already sat with the defendants on previous occasions before filing of the present suit. Therefore, he submits that no fruitful purpose shall be served in sending the parties for Pre-Institution Mediation.

6. In view of the fact that summons are being issued and time to file reply is being granted to the defendants, the present application is disposed of.

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7. Let the plaint be registered as suit.

8. Issue summons. Summons is accepted by learned counsel appearing for the defendants.

9. Let the written statement be filed by the defendants within thirty days from today. Along with the written statement, the defendants shall also file affidavit of admission/denial of the plaintiff's documents, without which, the written statement shall not be taken on record.

10. Liberty is given to the plaintiff to file replication within thirty days from the date of receipt of the written statement. Further, along with the replication, if any, filed by the plaintiff, an affidavit of admission/denial of documents of the defendants, be filed by the plaintiff, without which, the replication shall not be taken on record. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of the documents, the same shall be sought and given within the



timelines.

11. Issue notice in *I.A. 1466/2025*.
12. Let reply be filed within a period of four weeks.
13. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks, thereafter.
14. List before the Joint Registrar (Judicial) for marking of exhibits, on 21st March, 2025.
15. List before the Court on 10th March, 2025.
