1. These two petitions are primarily with the identical prayers, though in W.P.(C) 851/2026 the post involved is '*AC Plant Technician in Para Medical Cadre*'; whereas in W.P(C) 852/2026 the posts involved is '*ECG Technician in Para Medical Cadre*'.

2. The petitioners had come before this Court in an earlier round of litigation wherein the Court after noting the stand taken by the respondents, that the respondents shall undertake cadre review, had disposed of the same.



3. Ms Saahila Lamba, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners states that cadre review with regard to different posts in nursing and para medical cadre has already been carried out by Border Security Force (BSF). She seeks parity.
4. Today, the learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) had undertaken the cadre review with regard to the aforesaid two posts in the month of August, 2024 and had sent the recommendations to the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India in the month of February 2025. The decision is awaited from the Ministry before the same could be implemented. He seeks time to take instructions.
