3. The present writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeks to assail the order dated 08.01.2024 passed by the learned Central Administrative Tribunal in O.A. No. 2517/2023. Vide the impugned order, the learned Tribunal has rejected the petitioner's challenge to the transfer order 24.05.2023 whereby she was sought to be transferred from Delhi to Mumbai.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the husband of the petitioner being a CRPF Officer is posted in a hard area and, therefore, she is the only adult member in the family, who has to take care of her ailing in-laws. She, therefore, prays that respondent be directed to take compassionate view of her transfer and even if the petitioner cannot be retained in Delhi any further, she be transferred to a nearby place where she can commute easily by road.
5. Issue notice. Learned counsel for the respondent no. 1 accepts notice. He prays for and is granted two weeks' time to obtain instructions. He assures the Court that till the next date of hearing, the respondent will not take any coercive steps against the petitioner.
