5. The order dated 26.03.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Court is perused. Vide the said order, the Hon'ble Court has dismissed the application filed by the plaintiff to file Replication to the Written Statement filed by defendant no.1 to amended plaint and also Replication to Written Statement filed by defendant no.5 &6 to the amended plaint.

6. At this stage, learned counsel for the plaintiff points out that he has already filed an Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents in respect of the documents filed by defendant no.1 and defendant no.5&6 as his right to file the same has not been closed. Learned respective counsels for defendant no.1 and defendant no.5&6 strongly oppose filing of the said Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents by the plaintiff and rely on Chapter VII Rule 7 of Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules in this regard. Learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that he will file an appropriate application for taking on record the said Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff. Thereafter, the defendant no.1&defendant no.5&6 are at liberty to file reply to said application within three weeks with copy to the opposite side, who is at liberty to file rejoinder, if any, within three weeks thereafter with copy to the opposite side. Needless to say that such application, if

any, filed by the plaintiff shall be disposed of as per law.

7. Learned counsel for the plaintiff on instructions



proposes to refer the matter to Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre. Learned counsels for the defendants present today submit that they have no such instructions in this regard and will revert on the same, on the next date of hearing.

8. Further, the plaintiff has not filed an appropriate application in terms of submission made in para no.6 of the last order 13.12.2024 qua LRs of defendant no.2. The same be filed by the plaintiff within three weeks with copy to the opposite side.
