1. This hearing has been done through video conferencing.
2. Ms. Meghna De, ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the Workmen, i.e. for Respondents in W.P.(C) 11563/2019, 11566/2019, 5056/2020 and for Petitioners in W.P.(C) 411/2021, 569/2021 requests for an adjournment.
3. Mr. Vaibhav Kalra, ld. counsel for the Petitioner/Management in W.P.(C) 11563/2019, 11566/2019, 5056/2020 submits that he has not given no objection in respect of the adjournment request.
4. It is noticed that on 22nd October, 2020, these matters were partly heard in the application under Section 17B of The Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (*hereinafter*, “Act”). Thereafter, further applications were moved by



Workmen, for expeditious disposal of the application under Section 17B of the Act which were again decided on 23d November, 2020. Thereafter, repeated adjournments have been taken in these matters on 14th December, 2020, 8th March, 2021, and even today there is a request for an adjournment that has been sought, on behalf of the Workmen.

5. It is made clear that last and final opportunity is being given to the Workmen to argue the matters, failing which the Court would proceed to hear and adjudicate these matters.
