1. The Petitioner has filed the instant writ petition for a direction to the Respondents to refund of a sum of Rs. 3,25,752/- along with interest which is lying in credit of the Petitioner in the account of Respondents towards the payment of license fee.
2. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner draws the attention of this Court to the screenshot of the GNCTD for the year 2020-21, which indicates that a



sum of Rs.3,25,752/- is lying to the credit to the account of the Petitioner. The Petitioner had sent a letter to the Respondent on 22.07.2020 stating that they want to surrender the excise license from 31.03.2020 and demanded refund a sum of Rs.3,25,752/- which is lying to their credit.
