2. At the oral request of counsel for the petitioner, *Karamchari Union (Recognized)*, *AIIMS, New Delhi* is impleaded as the respondent no.5 in the present writ petition.

3. Let amended memo of parties be filed within three (3) days.

4. The present writ petition has been filed seeking setting aside of the election process and the results of the elections to the *Karamchari Union, AIIMS* conducted on 16th January, 2026 for being in violation of the registered bye-laws.

5. Counsel appearing on behalf of respondents no.1 and 2 submits that in



terms of Section 22 of the Industrial Relations Code, 2020, the remedy of the petitioner would be to approach the Industrial Tribunal.

6. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks time to examine the aforesaid position.

7. Re-notify on 2nd March, 2026 in the category of '*Supplementary List*'.
