1. Post remand order of the Apex Court, the petition got restored to the file of this Court, wherein the petitioners have moved an application seeking amendment thereby questioning the very acquisition proceedings including the Award.
2. The Award is already produced at *Annexure P-5* to the petition.
3. The prayer for amendment is strenuously objected by the counsel for respondents as according to them, the said prayer is by way of afterthought and at belated stage.



4. Keeping the issue of limitation open and in view of the fact that the Award was already part of the petition, we deem it appropriate to allow the amendment application, to be carried out within a period of two weeks from today.
