1. Through the present writ petitions, *inter alia*, the Petitioners seek to challenge the *vires* of Rule 10A of the Central Civil Services (Commutation of Pension) Rules, 1981.

2. The learned counsel representing the Petitioners relies upon the



pendency of the W.P.(C) 19636/2025 and interim order passed on 23.12.2025 in the said case.

3. It has been disclosed to this Court that certain matters involving the same issue, including W.P.(C) 19636/2025, are listed on 11.02.2026 before the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial).

4. The learned counsel representing the Petitioners submits that the High Court of Punjab and Haryana as well as High Court of Madhya Pradesh have already taken a view against the Petitioners.

5. He further admits that a Division Bench of this Court has already decided the issue raised in the present case by a detailed judgment passed in ***Forum of Retired IPS Officers (FORIPSO) v. Union of India and Another*** : 2019 SCC OnLine Del 6610.

6. Keeping in view aforesaid facts, the present writ petitions are adjourned to 11.02.2026.

7. The office is also directed to list all the connected petitions on 11.02.2026 before the Bench for final disposal.
