ORDER

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23.01.2026

1. Let the plaint be registered as suit.
2. Issue summons. Summons is accepted by learned counsel appearing for defendant no. 1. Let written statement along with affidavit of admission-denial of document be filed within a period of thirty days from today.
3. Issue summons to defendant nos. 2 to 4, through all permissible modes.
4. The summons shall state that the written statement(s) shall be filed by the defendants, within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of summons. Along with the written statement(s), the defendants shall also file the



affidavit(s) of admission/denial of the documents of the plaintiff, without which, the written statement(s) shall not be taken on record.

5. Liberty is given to the plaintiff to file replication(s), if any, within thirty (30) days from the receipt of the written statement(s). Along with the replication(s) filed by the plaintiff, the affidavit(s) of admission/denial of the documents of defendants, be filed by the plaintiff, without which, the replication(s) shall not be taken on record.

6. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.

7. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of the documents, the same shall be sought and given within the timelines.

8. The application, being *I.A. 2041/2026*, has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2, read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (“CPC”).

9. Issue notice to the defendants, by all modes, returnable on the next date.

10. Notice is accepted by learned counsel for defendant no.1.

11. Issue notice to defendant nos. 2 to 4 by all permissible modes.

12. Let reply be filed, within a period of four weeks, from today.

13. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks, thereafter.

14. List before the Joint Registrar (Judicial), on 24rd March, 2026.

15. List before the Court on 08th May, 2026.
