1. This application has been moved on behalf of the appellants seeking condonation of delay of 286 days in filing the present appeal.
2. For the reasons stated in the present application, the delay of 286 days in filing the present appeal is condoned.
3. The application stands disposed of.

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4. The appellants/claimants have instituted the present appeal challenging the impugned judgment-cum-award dated 24.12.2023, passed by the learned Presiding Officer, MACT-01, (South-West District), Dwarka Courts, New Delhi, seeking enhancement of compensation.



5. It is submitted by learned counsel for the appellant that the learned MACT has not correctly assessed the income of the deceased.
6. Learned counsel for respondent No.3/Insurance Company is present on advance notice and he accepts notice.
7. No notice of the present appeal is required to be served for now upon respondents No. 1 and 2, as the vehicle in question was admittedly insured for third party liability and no recovery rights have been granted to the Insurance Company.
8. At this stage, this is a fit case to be referred to *Pre-Lok Adalat*, for the parties to negotiate and arrive at an amicable settlement.
9. Learned counsel for respondent No.3/Insurance Company has no objection to the same.
10. Accordingly, both the parties are directed to appear for the *Pre-Lok Adalat* Mediation before the learned Secretary, Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee, for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement, on 07.02.2024 at 03.00 p.m.
11. Awaiting the outcome of the *Pre-Lok Adalat* Mediation, re-notify before this Court on 15.07.2024.
