1. The present application has been filed by the plaintiff, seeking



condonation of delay of thirteen days in filing the reply to *I.A. 27481/2025*.

2. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the plaintiff submits that *vide* order dated 19th March, 2026, their right to file reply to the said application has been wrongly closed, as the reply on behalf of the plaintiff had already been filed on the same date, i.e., 19th March, 2026.
