ORDER

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17.04.2026

1. At the outset, Ms. Kaadambari Puri, learned Senior Counsel puts in appearance and submits that her name has been mentioned in the Memo of Parties for defendant no. 13, in CS(OS) 741/2025.
2. She submits that she had already indicated that she had been engaged by defendant no. 13 for the purposes of representation in one of the cases. However, she is not a part of the said firm.
3. She further submits that she has already supplied the relevant information with regard to defendant no. 13 on the summons itself.
4. Accordingly, learned counsel appearing for the plaintiff is directed to



amend the Memo of Parties in CS(OS) 741/2025, by deleting reference to Ms. Kaadambari Puri, Senior Advocate and her name may not be reflected in the Memo of Parties.

5. Let the needful be done by the plaintiff, within a period of one week, from today.

6. The present matter has been kept only for the purposes of taking instructions by the defendants with respect to referring the matter to mediation.

7. Learned counsels appearing for the defendant nos. 1 to 3 submit that they have no difficulty if the matter is referred for mediation.

8. However, the aforesaid is vehemently opposed by learned counsels appearing for defendant no. 8 and 9, who submit that they are also the contesting defendants.

9. Learned counsel appearing for defendant nos. 8 and 9 further submits that they have moved an application for transposition as plaintiff.

10. At this stage, learned counsel appearing for defendant nos. 1 to 3 submits that defendant no. 1 is the trust, while defendant nos. 2 and 3 are the beneficiary and the trustees.

11. He further submits that the present suits may not be taken as a suit for partition and the suits have been filed with prayer for seeking declaration, permanent injunction and rendition of accounts in respect of the estate of the deceased, i.e., Mr. Syed Habeeb Ur Rehman.

12. Learned counsel appearing for defendant no. 5 also submits that they do not wish for the matter to be referred to mediation.

13. The issue with regard to referring the matter to mediation is kept open.



14. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel appearing for defendant nos. 8 and 9, re-notify on 07th August, 2026.
