Pleadings are complete.

Cost in furtherance of order Dated 15.01.2024 has been paid on behalf of plaintiff to the learned counsel for defendant no. 1.

CC 18/2023(by defendant no. 1)

Right to file written statement to the counter-claim of defendant no. 2 has already been closed.

As per learned counsel for plaintiff, he had filed two written statements to the counter-claim and both were filed beyond the period of limitation as mentioned in the order Dated 21.05.2024.

There is no any application came on record for condonation of delay in filing written statement to the counter-claim.
