Today, the matters of two days i.e. 9th March, 2023 and 10th March, 2023 are being taken up, in view of Notification No.767/I-G-4/Genl.I/DHC dated 07.03.2023 and total 46 matters are listed today.

CS(OS) 73/2023 & I.A. No. 1946/2023 (for interim injunction)

It is stated by learned counsel for the defendant no.1 that he has filed Written Statement alongwith Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents, documents and reply to interim application vide diary no.443710/2023. However, the same are not on record. Learned counsel for the defendant no.1 undertakes to check up the same with the Registry and get the same placed on record after removing the objections, if any.

As per office note, the defendant no.2 has been duly served personally at his official address i.e. 10/33B, Yogmaya Mandir, Mehrauli, Delhi on 02.03.2023. The defendant no.2 has not filed Written Statement and none has appeared on behalf of defendant no.2 today.

Let Written Statement alongwith Affidavit of Admission/Denial of documents be filed by the defendant no.2 within 30 days of service of summons with copy to the opposite side. Thereafter, Replication, if any, alongwith Affidavit of Admission/Denial of documents be filed by the plaintiff within 30 days with copy to the opposite side.

In view of above and since the date before the Hon'ble Court is short, the matter may be placed before the Hon'ble Court on date already fixed i.e. 16.03.2023, for further directions.
