As per office note, Written Statement, Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents and the documents filed by the defendant no.1 are already on record. The plaintiff has not filed Replication and Affidavit of Admission/Denial to the same till date. Learned counsel for the plaintiff seeks sometime to file the same. Needless to say, the same shall be made part of the record as per law.

The defendant no.2 has not filed any Written Statement till date. There is no appearance on behalf of the defendant no.2 today to explain in this regard. So, the right of the defendant no.2 to file Written Statement is ordered to be forfeited.

Reply to captioned IA filed by the defendant no.1 is already on record but rejoinder to the same has not been filed by the plaintiff till date. Learned counsel for the plaintiff seeks sometime to file the same. In the interest of justice and subject to imposition of cost of Rs.2000/- to be paid to the defendant no.1 by the plaintiff, the last and final opportunity is granted to the plaintiff to file rejoinder, if



any, within a week with copy to the opposite side.

No reply to captioned IA has been filed by the defendant no.2 till date. Even otherwise, there is no appearance on behalf of the defendant no.2 today to explain in this regard. So, the right of the defendant no.2 to file reply is ordered to be closed.

Counter claim filed by the defendant no.1

Heard. The Registry is directed to register and number the Counter Claim as per law.

Learned counsel for the plaintiff accepts notice of Counter Claim.

Let Written Statement, if any, be filed by the plaintiff within statutory period with copy to the opposite side. Replication, if any, alongwith Affidavit of Admission/Denial of documents be filed by the defendant no.1/Counter Claimant within stipulated period as prescribed by law with copy to the opposite side.

Issue notice of Counter Claim to the defendant no.2 by all permissible modes on taking steps by the Counter Claimant/defendant no.1.

In view of above and since the date before the Hon'ble Court is short, the matter may be placed before the Hon'ble Court on date already fixed i.e. 22.05.2023, for further directions.
