1. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the appellant/
accused is suffering from advanced Glaucoma which is affecting his
eyesight and hence, surgery is required.

2. The Senior Medical Officer, Jail Dispensary, Central Jail
no. 1, Tihar, New Delhi has given a report dated 16.01.2016 which
reads thus –

Subject: Medical status report of Patient/Inmate Shri Kishan S/o Chandu Lal.

With reference to the Hon'ble High Court seeking medical report of the aforesaid inmate/patient to be submitted as per given date.

As per available medical record inmate patient is a known case of External Haemorrhoid Grade II, Hypertension and Low Back Ache with radiculopathy apart from few Dental related complaints for which he is receiving treatment from Jail Dispensary and DDU Hospital.

On 15.05.2025 inmate patient presented in Jail Dispensary for his complaint of decreased of vision for which after being evaluated by Jail Visiting EYE SR he was referred to DDU Hospital for further management.

On 30.05.2025 inmate patient was sent to Surgery Department, DDU Hospital for his complaints of bilateral eye decreased of vision wherein he gave history of both eye cataract surgery, accordingly, he was advised eye drops and sent back to CJ-01.

On 06.11.2025 inmate patient was sent to Surgery Department of DDU Hospital for his complaints of painful defecation & bleeding PR, he was examined and on examination External fissure at 12 'O' Clock, Skin tag at 6 'O' Clock and External Haemorrhoid at 3, 5, 7, 11 'O' Clock and he was diagnosed as



External Haemorrhoid Grade II. He was advised for Sitz Bath, Fibre Rich Diet and also advised to avoid straining during defecation and further he was put on conservative treatment.

On the same day i.e. 06.11.2025 inmate patient also visited at Orthopaedics Department of DDU Hospital for his complaints of Low Back ache with radiculopathy towards right leg wherein he was examined and advised medication.

Thereafter, on 12.11.2025 inmate patient was sent to Medicine OPD of DDU Hospital for his complaint of chest pain and gave history of Hypertension he was examined and advised anti-hypertensive medication and further advice to review with some blood investigations, ECG and Chest x-rays.

On 12.11.2025 inmate patient was sent to Eye OPD of DDU Hospital as a follow up case of right secondary advanced glaucoma (End stage) wherein he was examined and advised eye drops with advice to review after 3-4 months.

He was again sent to Medicine Department of DDU Hospital on 22.11.2025 for his persistent complaints of all over chest pain, cough (dry) wherein at this time he was advised for BP Charting and blood investigations.

On the same day i.e. 22.11.2025 inmate patient reported in Jail Dispensary for his complaints of painful defecation and bleeding PR wherein this time his proctoscopy was conducted and haemorrhoid at 3 'O Clock & 11 'O position was noted. Inmate patient was again advised for Sitz Bath and fibre rich diet and to avoid straining during defecation.



Thereafter on 08.01.2025 & 15.01.2026 inmate patient reported at DDU Hospital for Surgery follow-up with complaint of no relief of symptoms for which he was thoroughly examined and provided necessary advice.

On 15.01.2026 inmate patient was sent to Orthopaedics Department of DDU Hospital for his complaints of low back ache with radiculopathy since one year and advised medications.

At present, inmate patient is suffering from right secondary advanced glaucoma (End stage) which is affecting his eye sight, bleeding per rectum (External Haemorrhoid Grade II), Hypertension and Low Back Ache with radiculopathy for which he is being provided treatment and is also under follow up from DDU Hospital and Jail Visiting Specialist but not getting relief with persisting symptoms.

This is for your kind information and onward submission.

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3. In light of the report, it is seen that the appellant/accused is being provided with necessary medical treatment. However, it has been submitted that, in view of his present eye condition, surgery may also be required. Accordingly, the Jail Superintendent concerned is directed to make arrangements for taking the appellant/accused to the hospital for medical examination. The



doctor concerned shall examine him and advise whether surgery is required or not.

4. The report of the doctor shall be placed on record by the next date of hearing. The Jail Superintendent concerned shall also submit a report indicating whether it would be possible to make the necessary arrangements for such treatment while the appellant/accused continues to remain in jail.
