CM APPL. 6930/2026 (Exemption)

1. Exemption allowed subject to just exceptions.
2. Application stands disposed of, accordingly.

CM APPL. 6929/2026 (Condonation of delay)

1. For the reasons, as stated in the said application, the same is allowed.
2. The delay is condoned.
3. Application stands disposed of, accordingly.

MAC.APP. 95/2026

1. This appeal has been filed seeking enhancement of compensation awarded by the impugned award dated 28th July 2025 in MACT No.22/2023, where the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal (*'Tribunal'*) awarded compensation of Rs.14,42,040/- along with interest @ 7.5% per annum.
2. Appellant/injured claimant was injured in an accident on 19th December 2020 while travelling on his motorcycle where he suffered permanent disability of 51% to his left leg, as per his Disability Certificate.



However, his functional disability was assessed at 25% by the Tribunal, while calculating the future earning capacity.

3. *Mr. S.N. Parashar*, Counsel for appellant/ injured claimant further states that this assessment was highly conservative considering, the circumstances of the injury.

4. He further states that compensation on non-pecuniary losses was highly depressed and inadequate.

5. Accordingly, issue notice.

6. Notice is accepted by counsel appearing on behalf of Insurance Company/respondent no.3.

7. Issue notice to respondent nos.1 and 2 on steps being taken by the appellant through all permissible modes, including email, since recovery rights have been also granted by the Tribunal.

8. Trial Court Record be also requisitioned and placed on record. Digital copy of the same be supplied to the counsels for the parties, if so requested.

9. Counsels for parties will file their respective note of arguments not exceeding *three pages*, synopsisizing their contentions along with *list of citations*, which they wish to rely upon, cross-referencing *PDF pages* of the Court File. The same will be exchanged *inter se* counsels *at least three days* prior to the next date of hearing.

10. List before the Joint Registrar (Judicial) on 02nd March 2026.

11. Parties are referred to *Pre-sitting Lok Adalat* for resolution of disputes.

12. After completion of service, matter will be listed before the *Pre-sitting Lok Adalat*, as per directions given by the Joint Registrar (Judicial).



13. Concerned officer from Insurance Company, who is authorised to take decisions, shall be present, either physically or through VC, before the *Pre-sitting Lok Adalat*.
14. Copy of order be sent to Secretary, *Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee* for information and compliance.
15. List before the Court on 07th July 2026.
16. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court.
