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1. Mr. *Parashar*, learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 1 and 2, submits that the appellant has challenged the impugned order solely on the ground that the claim is barred by the principles of *res judicata*. He submits that the respondents/claimants had earlier approached the learned Commissioner at Bulandshahr under the Employee's Compensation Act. However, the said claim application was withdrawn at the instance of the respondents themselves, as they had shifted their base from Bulandshahr to Delhi and were finding it difficult to pursue the proceedings there. He further submits that the earlier claim filed before the MACT was also withdrawn in view of the claim petition filed before the learned Commissioner, Bulandshahr. He, thus, submits that the contentions raised by



the appellant are devoid of merit and, in any event, stood rejected by the learned Commissioner vide order dated 06.12.2019.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant seeks time to rebut the aforesaid submissions.
4. Renotify on 07.09.2026.
5. It is clarified that no further adjournment would be granted to the appellant.
