I.A. 2174/2023 (exemption from filing certified copy of documents)

The application for exemption is allowed, subject to the plaintiffs granting inspection of the documents filed, as and when required to do so, or filing the original documents at the stage of admission/denial.

The application stands disposed of.

CS(OS) 80/2023

1. The plaint be registered as a suit. Summons be issued to the defendant by all permissible modes, including e-mail on filing of process fee. *Dasti* service in addition is also permitted. Affidavit of service be filed within one week.
2. The summons shall indicate that the written statement must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons. The defendant



shall also file affidavit of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiffs, failing which the written statement shall not be taken on record.

3. The plaintiffs are at liberty to file replications thereto within fifteen days after filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendant, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.

4. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.

5. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

6. List before the learned Joint Registrar for marking of exhibits on 13.04.2023.

7. List before the Court on 28.02.2023.

I.A. 2173/2023 (application under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of the CPC)

1. Issue notice. Notice be served by all permissible modes, including e-mail. *Dasti* service in addition is also permitted. Affidavit of service be filed within one week.

2. Mr. Nikhli. A. Menon, learned counsel for the plaintiffs, does not press for *ad interim* orders at the *ex parte* stage.

3. List on 28.02.2023.

I.A. 2175/2023 (for exemption from advance service of the plaint)
