1. This application has been filed on behalf of respondent workmen, seeking clarification as to whether there is stay operating against the award dated 18.10.2023 of Industrial Tribunal impugned in the present matter. I do not find any requirement of any clarification. It appears that vide order dated 13.05.2024, learned counsel for respondent had stated before the predecessor bench that execution proceedings would not be pressed till next date (17.09.2024). Thereafter there is no continuation of such assurance since on next two dates the matter could not reach till end of the day.

2. The application is disposed of accordingly.

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3. However, in order to remove all confusion in the minds of parties, it is directed that subject to the petitioner depositing entire awarded amount with



the Registry of this Court within two weeks, the execution of the impugned award shall remain stayed till next date. However, it is made clear that if the said amount is not deposited within the said period, there shall be no stay on the execution proceedings. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner submits that keeping in mind the amount involved, a period of four weeks may be granted. Accordingly, the said amount be deposited within four weeks but not later.
