3. The present petition has been filed seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent-husband for disobeying the protection orders dated 04th July, 2023, 19th July, 2023, 17th August, 2023, 06th December, 2023, 07th December, 2023 and 16th January, 2024 passed by the learned Metropolitan Magistrate ("MM"), Saket District Court in CC No. 1083/2023.



4. It is submitted that petitioner is a 43-year-old domestic worker who has been married to respondent no. 1 since the year 1999. It is submitted that the petitioner has been physically, sexually, verbally, mentally and economically abused since the beginning of her marriage. Thus, she approached the Court many times pursuant to which the aforesaid protection orders have been passed in favour of the petitioner. It is submitted that despite the aforesaid protection orders, respondent no. 1 is continuing with his abuse and is extending threats to the petitioner time and again.

5. Thus, it is submitted that due to the aforesaid threats by respondent no. 1, the petitioner is unable to lead a peaceful life at her home and is also finding it difficult to visit her place of work.

6. Attention of this Court has been drawn to the order dated 7th December, 2023, attached as *Annexure P-23* to the present petition, wherein the respondent no. 1 had given an undertaking before the Court of the MM that he shall not contact the petitioner herein.

7. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has been staying separately from her husband, i.e., respondent no. 1. However, respondent no. 1 till date tries to enter her residence in order to harass the petitioner and her children.

8. Issue notice.

9. Notice is accepted by learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 2 to 6.

10. Let notice be issued to respondent no. 1 by all modes.

11. It is directed that the petitioner as well as respondent no. 1 shall be present in the Court on the next date of hearing.



12. The local SHO of Police Station, Kalindi Kunj shall ensure the presence of respondent no. 1 before this Court on the next date of hearing.

13. Re-notify on 22nd February, 2024.
