Mr. Bhattacharya, learned counsel appearing for the Official Liquidator submits that disbursements in terms of the order passed by this Court on 21.10.2019 have been made towards the claim of the EPFO completely. Insofar as the claims of the workmen mentioned in the said order are concerned, Mr. Bhattacharya seeks a period of six weeks more to disburse the claims.

Let the amounts mentioned in the order dated 21.10.2019 be disbursed by the Official Liquidator positively within a period of six weeks from today.

Mr. Bhattacharya further submits that *de hors* the claims mentioned in the order dated 21.10.2019, the claims of certain workmen have been overlooked by the Committee and there is an anomaly. On this account, he seeks liberty to take up the matter with the Committee.

Needless to state that no liberty is required by the Official Liquidator. It is always open to the office of the Official Liquidator to approach the Committee to seek any rectification of the errors that may have crept in.
