It is submitted by the learned counsel for the ex-management that he has filed the objections to the claims filed by the workmen before the committee. On 21.08.2015, the ex-management was given an opportunity to seek inspection of the records available with the



Official Liquidator and present specific objections to the figures as ascertained by the Committee along with documents to substantiate their objections. The ex-management was also given an opportunity to approach the EPFO for the copy of the relevant records pertaining to the workmen and EPFO was further directed to cooperate and provide copies/inspection of the requisite records to enable the ex-management as well as the Official Liquidator to finalise the workmen's dues. It was clarified that ex-management would have to substantiate their figures with sufficient material and that the Official Liquidator shall consider the objections and the material relied upon by the ex-management and take a final view in the matter and would submit a comprehensive report. It is stated that till date such objections have not been filed by the ex-management. Learned counsel for the ex-management submits that the objections were filed yesterday vide diary No. 6448. A copy of the objections has been supplied to the Official Liquidator and all concerned.

Let the Official Liquidator file a comprehensive report within four weeks from today.
