CRL.M.A. 3998/2026 (exemption)

1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

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2. Petitioner seeks quashing of case FIR No. 525/2025 of Police Station Moti Nagar for offence under Section 289/125(a) BNS on the ground that the complainant *de facto* (respondent no.2) has compromised the disputes with the petitioner.

3. Broadly speaking, in the course of employment, the present respondent no.2 suffered injury by way of loss of four fingers of his left hand.

4. Learned counsel for State accepts notice on behalf of ASC.



5. Respondent no.2 identified by IO/SI Narender also accepts notice.
6. The compromise arrived at between the parties is that towards loss of four fingers, the petitioner would pay a total amount of Rs.3,00,000/- and shall continue the employment of respondent no.2 till the day of his retirement.
7. On being asked, learned counsel for petitioner fairly submits that according to calculations under Employees' Compensation Act, the compensation payable is approximately Rs.7,50,000/-.
8. As submitted by learned APP, the concern is that if after paying Rs.3,00,000/-, within a few months services of respondent no.2 are terminated by petitioner, the former would have to again litigate.
9. Therefore, I have explained the entire situation to respondent no.2 and his son present in court today in Hindi.
