6. Reply to the application for stay be filed within six weeks. Rejoinder



thereto, if any, be filed within four weeks thereafter.

7. Subject to the appellant depositing, within six weeks, 75% of the awarded amount with the learned Tribunal, the operation of the impugned award will remain stayed till the next date.
