1. The plaint be registered as suit.
2. Issue summons to the defendants.
3. Mr. Hrishikesh Baruah, learned counsel appearing on behalf of defendant no.2 and Mr. Aditya Gupta, learned counsel appearing on behalf of defendant no.4, accept summons and waive formal service of summons.
4. They submit that copy of the plaint, I.A.s and documents have been received by them.
5. On plaintiff taking steps, summons be issued to defendant nos.1, 3



and 5 by all permissible modes.

6. The summons shall indicate that written statement must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of summons.

7. The defendants shall also file an affidavit of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statement shall not be taken on record.

8. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replication thereto within thirty days after filing of the written statement. The replication shall be accompanied by affidavit of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replication shall not be taken on record.

9. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.

10. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

11. List before the learned Joint Registrar for completion of service, pleadings, admission/denial of documents and marking of exhibits on 23.04.2026.

12. List before Court thereafter on a date assigned by the learned Joint Registrar.

13. Issue notice.

14. Mr. Hrishikesh Baruah, learned counsel appearing on behalf of defendant no.2 and Mr. Aditya Gupta, learned counsel appearing on behalf of defendant no.4, accept notice.

15. On plaintiff taking steps, issue notice to defendant nos.1, 3 and 5 by



all permissible modes.

16. Let reply be filed within a period of two weeks from today.
17. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed before the next date.
18. The prayer for interim relief shall be considered after completion of pleadings.
