Learned counsel appearing for Mr.Amar Nath Tiwari has vehemently submitted that the property in question which is Anupam Hotel, Patna, Bihar has to come to him in view of the fact that the entire dues of Bihar State Financial Corporation (BSFC) have been paid. He also relies upon prayer clause (c) of CA No. 1561/2011 where BSFC has prayed that they would hand over the property to Mr.Amar Nath Tiwari. Learned Counsel for BSFC however points out that there is no settlement with Mr.Tiwari. He also submits that the acts of BSFC were challenged by Mr.Amar Nath Tiwari before the Patna High Court where the writ petitions were dismissed.

Let BSFC place on record the necessary documents to support their



plea that Mr.Amar Nath Tiwari has no right, title or interest subsisting in the said property.
