Today's Court proceedings are conducted through hybrid mode.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is urgency in the matter because a contempt petition against the petitioner is pending before the CAT and in view of this, he requests that the matter be listed before the Hon'ble Court for appropriate orders. Counsel for the respondents opposes this request on the ground that service is yet to be completed on some of the respondents.
