1. The Status Report has been filed on behalf of the Official Liquidator wherein permission is sought for disbursement of the due amount to the workmen.
2. It is stated that there are about 599 workmen in all to whom the disbursements have to be made though, some of them have failed to submit the documents or come forth to claim the amounts. The Official Liquidator is directed to take effective steps to ensure the disbursement to all the workmen including who have been verified by Justice Dhingra Committee, who approach the Official Liquidator and submit the further Report within



one month.

3. In the Status Report, permission is also sought to pay the Auction Purchaser Rs.13,53,226/- towards preferential expenses and Rs.17,53,083/- towards liquidation expenses.

4. Learned counsel on behalf of the Official Liquidator seeks time to furnish the further details of the date when the sale price was deposited with the Official Liquidator and also would indicate the persons to whom this money to be disbursed along with the documents in support of these amounts.
