1. Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the parties jointly submit that despite multiple opportunities, no Reply(ies) to these Applications have been filed by the office of the OL. Learned Counsel submit that in view of this delay, the Applicants who are the Auction Purchasers, Creditors, Guarantors, Ex-Directors and Employees Provident Fund Organisation are not being able to proceed in their respective matters and are also facing coercive actions against other third-party agencies.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the IDBI Bank, IFCI and Bank of Baroda are also granted four weeks to file their Reply(eis) failing which, the same will be taken on record subject to payment of costs in the sum of Rs.5,000/- for each delayed Reply to be paid to the *Bar Council of Delhi-Indigent and Disabled Lawyers Account.* If delayed, proof of costs shall be attached with the Reply.

4. Rejoinder(s) thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.

5. Let copies of these Applications be provided by the Applicants to the opposite parties/Banks within two days under acknowledgement.
