Learned counsel appearing for Jhalani Workers Kundli Unit has pointed out that on 08.11.2013, this court had on CA No. 2061/2013 clearly stated that the pendency of the said application i.e. CA No. 2061/2013 shall



not be an impediment for disbursal of the dues payable to the workmen. He submits that on 03.10.2018 the said application i.e. CA No. 6010/2013 was withdrawn.

Now, Dena Bank has on behalf of the secured creditors filed a similar application being CA No. 1313/2018 which is needlessly holding up the disbursal of the dues of the workmen.

Learned counsel appearing for the Official Liquidator seeks to file a reply to this application.

Reply be filed within four weeks.

In the meantime, the representatives of the workers and the secured creditors may have a meeting with the Official Liquidator on 14.01.2019 at 3.00 p.m. in the office of the Official Liquidator. The Official Liquidator may try and sort out the matter. If the matter is sorted out, the Official Liquidator may move an appropriate application in court for disbursal of the dues of the workers.
