1. By this application, the applicant seeks release of amounts stated to be due from several companies under liquidation.
2. Mr. Rishi Manchanda, learned counsel for the Official Liquidator, submits, on instructions, that it has been verified that the amount of ₹ 1,47,500/- is, in fact, due to the applicant, in respect of M/s Jhalani Tools India Ltd.
3. Accordingly, the Official Liquidator is directed to release the said amount to the applicant, within a period of one week from today, and to place a compliance report on record, in these proceedings.
4. In order to avoid multiplicity of litigation, the Official Liquidator is also directed to look into the other amounts stated to be payable to the applicant and, if they are found to be payable, to release the said amounts to the applicant, as expeditiously as possible.
5. The application stands disposed of.
