1. This is an application whereby the applicant workman seeks release of money as per the letter issued by the O.L. in this behalf. This letter is dated 13.09.2017. Strangely, the O.L. has called upon the applicant workman of the company in liquidation to apply to this court for release of the balance 56% of the payment to him for the reason that there is no specific order issued in that behalf by the court.
2. According to me, the O.L. should have filed a report stating therein that the claims have been quantified and that the permission be given to him for release the money to the concerned workman. The O.L., to my mind, should not have needlessly asked the applicant to approach the court for that purpose.
3. Accordingly, Mr. Deepak Anand, Standing Counsel for the O.L. shall file a reply to this application within one week from today bearing



in mind what is observed herein above.
