The learned counsel for the applicant submits that in terms of the order dated 03.09.2014 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in Company Appeal No. 69/2013 title ***Jhalani Tools Workers Union Faridabad v. M/s Jhalani Tools India Limited (In Liquidation)***, the amount has not been released to the workmen who were part of the OTS.

5. The learned counsel for the Official Liquidator submits that only few workmen remain to be paid on account of their documents not been available with the Official Liquidator.

6. Though the learned counsel for the applicant submits that all the documents of all the workmen have been duly submitted with the Official Liquidator, it is directed that the workmen, who yet remain to be paid in terms of the above referred order passed by the Division Bench, shall approach the Official Liquidator with the copies of the required documents, which are the bank details and the indemnity bond. On the receipt of such documents, the payment shall be released to such workmen by the Official Liquidator within a period of one week of receipt of such documents.
