1. This petition has been filed for quashing of complaint bearing CC No. 625011/2016 under Section 138 N.I. Act and the proceedings emanating therefrom pending in the Court of Ld. MM (NI Act)-05, South East, Saket District Court, New Delhi, on the ground that the contentions which have been placed by the petitioners that the amount of liability, if at all, was not the same as the cheques which were presented, has now been confirmed *vide* an Award dated 31.07.2015 passed by the Ld. Sole Arbitrator Hon'ble Mr. Justice S.B. Sinha, Former Judge, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the petition under Section 34 of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act assailing the
