1. This application seeks early hearing of C.A. 1068/2016 and C.A. 1217/2016.
2. The applicant relies on orders, dated 2nd February, 2016 and 4th March, 2016, in support of the prayer for early hearing.

3. In view of the observations in the said orders, it would be appropriate to hear this matter on a fixed date.
4. Mr. Prashanto Sen, learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of M/s Ceylon Biscuits Ltd. submits that it would be necessary to hear the ex-management of the company under liquidation, i.e. M/s Bakemans Industries Pvt. Ltd., apart from various other parties, before this application is decided, and that it would not be legally permissible to decide this application without hearing them.
5. Ms. Sangeeta Chandra, who appears for the Official Liquidator, also points out that this matter had come up earlier, and was heard for some time, and involves perusal of voluminous records.
6. The mere fact that perusal of voluminous records may be required to be seen, cannot inhibit early hearing of the application.
7. Accordingly, the application for early hearing is allowed.
8. List C.A. 1068/2016 and C.A. 1217/2016 for hearing on 26th August, 2020.
9. The submission of Mr. Sen, that all necessary parties have not been impleaded in this application, and that disposal of this application would require hearing of the ex-management of Bakemans Industries Pvt. Ltd. and other parties, would also be considered on the said date. However, Ms. Tara Ganju submits that all necessary parties have been intimated of the hearing of this application.

10. C.A. 391/2020 stands disposed of accordingly.
