1. Counsel for the defendants states that written statement will be filed within next two days and which is the outer limit of 120 days fixed for filing of written statement in commercial suits. Plaintiffs will file replication/replications to the written statement of the defendants within four weeks from today.

2. Parties will file documents in their power and possession within two weeks and admission/denial thereof be done within two weeks thereafter by filing an affidavit annexing thereto a list of documents of the other side with an additional column of endorsement of admission/denial.

Since the subject suit is a commercial suit, admission/denial will not be general but will be specific containing reasons.

3. After completion of admission/denial, any of the parties can file an application for summary judgment under Order XIII-A of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC) and pleadings in this application will be completed by the Joint Registrar before listing the matter in the Court. The date fixed in the Court will be the date for disposal of all pending applications, case management hearing and framing of issues.
