It is stated that the counter affidavit was filed on 14th July, 2017. The same is not on record. Let the same be placed on record after removing office objections, if any, within ten days.

Rejoinder affidavit may be filed within six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner nos.4 and 5 namely Savitri Devi and Nand Lal were granted benefit of financial up gradation under the Assured Career Progression Scheme. However, while revising the pension pursuant to the recommendations of the 6th Pay commission, the respondents have not taken into consideration the financial up gradation granted to them.

The respondent no.4 will examine the aforesaid contention and file an affidavit in this Court explaining the position, in case the pension as per the respondents has been correctly paid. However, in



case, the said petitioners are entitled to higher or increased pension, the same would be granted to them. This order would be treated as an order issuing notice.
