ORDER

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1. Vide the present petition, the petitioner has primarily assailed the order dated 16.12.2021 passed by the Review Committee on Wilful Defaulters ('the review committee') of the respondent bank declaring him as a wilful defaulter.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned order is completely bereft of any reason and is therefore liable to be set aside on this ground alone. In support of his submission, he has placed reliance on the decision of the Apex Court in *State Bank of India v. Jah Developers Private Limited [(2019) 6 SCC 787]*.
3. On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent, who appears on advance notice, submits that when the petitioner himself chose not to submit any representation, the review committee cannot be faulted



for not dealing with any of the issues now sought to be raised by the petitioner.

4. In the light of the aforesaid stand taken by the respondent, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for, and is granted, one week's time to obtain instructions/file additional affidavit.
